EDUCATIONAL

Our total immersion method allows the participants to learn a great deal during our language courses. Lessons are taught in groups of around 10 participants, depending on age and language skills.

The course materials have been developed by experts in foreign language courses and are closely linked to the participants' daily lives.

Our language courses take place in areas where the target language is spoken locally. Contact with the locals, immersion in a foreign culture as well as excursions in the area: this combination turns the course into an enriching experience.

There's a wide range of recreational and creative activities: workshops, all kinds of sports, big games, singing sessions, excursions, ... these activities will stimulate the participants to actively use the foreign language in all kinds of very different situations.

Each of our language courses has 1 instructor for every 4 participants.

An instructor is at least 18 years old. Their selection is a careful process and they receive additional training during the year.

OUR FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES



FOCUS ON TARGET LANGUAGE

ACTIVE PRESENCE

12-19 YEARS

The target language is always the central focus at Roeland. Students and instructors speak only the target language for the duration of the camp. If participants deliberately keep speaking their own mother tongue, we will contact their parents.

JUNIOR (7-13 YEARS)

The instructors of the junior camp speak the target language at all times, but the children are allowed to speak their mother tongue amongst themselves. In this age group we are more flexible with this basic principle, as the children do not yet possess enough basic knowledge of the language to be able to express themselves properly in the target language. Our instructors encourage students to speak the target language all day long - at mealtimes, while they are doing sports, during workshops and on outings. This ensures that for kids, language learning is a natural process and progress feels effortless.

We listen to the kids and allow them to make their own contributions to ensure that each camp is a successful and unique learning experience. From the age of 15 onwards, young people are given more freedom to arrange various aspects of their language vacation to suit them. We give them more responsibility and ensure that they get to have their say.



Our experienced language instructors are always on hand to help our students. They tactfully correct any language mistakes while encouraging the students to improve their knowledge of the language they are learning. The individual attention they receive ensures that students make great progress during our language courses.




